

AVEC VUE

Domaine du Burignon

AOC Lavaux, Saint-Saphorin **Grand Cru**

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Perched on the heights of Saint-Saphorin, the Burignon estate is one of the three Lausanne wine enclaves in Lavaux.

In 1802, during the sale of national properties, Lausanne acquired these vineyards, covering an area of around 6 hectares.

A sandy, light soil, which allows a deep rooting, a slope on the hillside of between 35% and 50%, many stone walls which reflect the heat, the plots of Burignon offer a perfect representation of the soil of Lavaux, where the wines are at one with the terroir.



VINEYARD AND VINIFICATION

Orientation

- South on a hillside with a steep slope

Soil

- Sandy fluvioglacial moraine

Grape variety

- Chasselas

Culture

- Simple Guyot, terraced vineyard

Vinification

- Ageing in wooden vase for 8 months



TASTING

Bright colour with light silver reflections. The mineral nose is open and complex with notes of yellow fruit, citrus and dried fruit. It inspires a romantic invitation to stroll in an orchard in full bloom.

The attack is sharp, the mid-palate is ripe and the finish tends to a magnificent balance underlined by the freshness of the wine, which is extremely appreciated.



FOOD AND WINE PAIRING

To be served between 8°C and 10°C with perch fillets *à la meunière*. This wine is also recommended with asparagus puffs or why not with homemade vol-au-vent.
