

IL N'ÉTAIT QU'UNE FOIS

Domaine du Burignon

AOC Lavaux, Saint-Saphorin Grand Cru

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Perched on the heights of Saint-Saphorin, the Burignon estate is one of the three Lausanne wine enclaves in Lavaux.

In 1802, during the sale of national properties, Lausanne acquired these vineyards, covering an area of around 6 hectares.

A sandy, light soil, which allows a deep rooting, a slope on the hillside of between 35% and 50%, many stone walls which reflect the heat, the plots of Burignon offer a perfect representation of the soil of Lavaux, where the wines are at one with the terroir.



VINEYARD AND VINIFICATION

Orientation	• South-west set on a steep hillside
Soil	• Sandy fluviogalcial moraine
Grape variety	• Viognier
Culture	• Simple Guyot
Vinification	• Ageing in 3rd passage barrique



TASTING

Bright colour with light yellow reflections. Sunny nose with notes of dried apricots reminiscent of the south. The attack is generous and supported by a lot of freshness. It has a complex finish, which joins citrus fruits from the nearby orchards.



FOOD AND WINE PAIRING

To be served at 8°C with a shank of veal and cooked apples or a rack of pork roasted with rosemary honey.
